Illinois 2005 (13U) MRL Qualifying Division



PURPOSE

- Season-long competition to determine which teams earn spot for 13U MRL in Spring 2018
- Provide meaningful matches for teams in the 2005 age division and help teams prepare for MRL
- Determine seeds for 2005 (13U) State Cup in the Spring

Team Registration

To be considered for MRL your team had to have registered with an Illinois Youth Soccer league (IWSL, CIYSL, SLYSA or YSSL).

You register all players and get player cards thru that member league. You use those league cards during MRL Qualifying Division play.

Illinois MRL Qualifying Division teams are responsible for self-scheduling each of their matches. Illinois Youth Soccer has created a schedule which you can find in your GotSoccer account. To schedule your matches you should:

- 1. Contact your opponent via phone or email See Slide 9 for schedules & contact info
- 2. Mutually agree on a date, time and location
- Email finalized game info to <u>ilstatepremiership@gmail.com</u> NO LATER THAN AUGUST 15

DO NOT INCLUDE IYSA STAFF ON BACK AND FORTH COMMUNICATIONS ABOUT POTENTIAL GAMES. ONLY SEND IYSA FINAL GAME DETAILS

Once you have finalized details on a match, the **HOME** team should email the following details to ilstatepremiership@gmail.com no later than AUGUST 15 Team names (both) & age group

- Date of match
- 2. Time of match
- Specific location of match (address & field #)

TEAMS MUST HAVE THEIR SCHEDULE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED TO THE ILLINOIS YOUTH SOCCER OFFICE NO LATER THAN AUGUST 15. Failure to meet the scheduling deadline may result in per day fines to BOTH clubs

Although teams schedules are due to the Illinois Youth Soccer office by AUGUST 15, teams are allowed unlimited game changes. To get a game changed after the AUGUST 15 schedule deadline teams must do the following no later than 72-hrs prior to the originally scheduled match:

Email chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org a new agreed upon date, time and location that BOTH teams agree on. Representatives from BOTH teams should be included on the email. NO GAME CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED WITHOUT THIS INFORMATION. Games cancelled by teams without emailing this information may result in a forfeit.

All matches should be completed no later than October 29.

Teams that DO NOT complete all matches may be excluded from MRL consideration.

Qualifying Division games are home team host and self schedule. *Teams are expected to travel to the home field of their opponent unless both teams agree otherwise.*

As this competition is designed to help prepare teams for MRL, teams are also encouraged to work together to coordinate weekends of play with multiple games like teams do for MRL.

If any contact info incorrect, simply update the contact info for the team in your GotSoccer account and contact info will automatically update online.

November 3-5

Because teams will be placed directly into MRL Premier I, Premier II, First Division and Qualifying Divisions in the Spring, based on the final standings additional games may be required to determine 1-5 for placement.

Those games will be scheduled November 3-5 in Rockford so teams should keep this weekend open.

Referees

The Illinois Youth Soccer assignors will assigns ALL 3 REFS FOR ALL GAMES.

State Referee Assignor Info

Clubs will have a specific ref assignor handling their ref assigning for the IL MRL Qualifying Division. Contact info for them will be available shortly in case you have any last minute changes, cancellations or referee no-shows for your match, you should contact the Illinois Youth Soccer referee assignor directly. Failure to contact the proper state assignor for any last minute game cancellations will incur an \$80 fine.

Fees: BOTH teams pay \$80 each to the center prior to the match starting

Roster

Teams are allowed to use any player from within their club that is registered with an Illinois Youth Soccer competitive league for State Premiership play. Those leagues are: CIYSL, ILLOWA, IWSL, SLYSA or YSSL.

- Teams can use up to 25 players during the Fall season
- All players must have a US Youth Soccer/ IYSA affiliated competitive league pass from and rostered thru one of the Illinois Youth Soccer affiliated member leagues listed above.
- A player can only play on one team during season
- Players from another club are NOT allowed to play for your team.

Any team found violating the roster limit or any of the above will forfeit games and may face additional sanctions

Roster

All players that will compete in the Illinois MRL Qualifying Division must be entered into GotSoccer in the official roster.

To enter the players in to your State Premiership roster:

- 1. Login to your GotSoccer account
- 2. In the Gray bar that runs along the top of the page select ROSTER
- 3. This will take you to a page that will show you the team roster. Above the list of players you will see a drop down box titled "VIEW BY EVENT" defaultly it will show your PRIMARY PLAYER LIST. From the drop down VIEW BY EVENT menu, select Illinois MRL Qualifying Division.
- 4. This will show you your current Qualifying Division roster and the names that will print on your gamecard. If you need to add players you can do it one of 2 ways
 - 1. If the player is on another team within your club and your GotSoccer account is part of a club account, you can select the ADD A CLUB PLAYER button, search for the player and then add them to the roster
 - 2. If it is a new player, from the VIEW BY EVENT drop down select PRIMARY PLAYER LIST. Click the ADD NEW PLAYER button and add the players information

Gameday

Teams are required to bring the following to all IL MRL Qualifying Division Games:

- 1. Gamecard printed off GotSoccer
 - Login to GotSoccer account
 - 2. Select Illinois MRL Qualifying Division
 - 3. Select SCHEDULE
 - 4. Click the PDF symbol with a # in the gray box to the left of the match. A PDF of your gamecard will pop-up in another browser window
- 2. Player and Coaching Passes
- 3. \$80 Payment for Referees

22 PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED TO DRESS ON GAMEDAYS. ALL PLAYERS NOT PLAYING SHOULD BE CROSSED-OFF THE GAME CARD

Gameday

At the conclusion of the match the **WINNING TEAM** (or home team if a draw) should submit the score to Illinois Youth Soccer **WITHIN 48-HRS**

- Emailing <u>chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org</u> a scanned copy of the gamecard
- 2. Fax gamecards to 847-290-1576
- 3. Submitting score via the call-in GotSoccer system.

If a **red card** is issued during the match, the center will keep the gamecard to submit with the red card report. Red cards = fines and suspensions for players (\$50) and coaches (\$300). Players and coaches are REQUIRED to sit out their at least next Qualifying Division match following a red card. Any team that uses a player that should be serving a red card suspension will forfeit the match and may be subject to additional sanctions. Teams may keep the pass for the player or coach that receives a red card
